	Location: Land east of Oak Farm, Templecombe Lane, Buckhorn Weston (Bramble Barn)	
	The outline application is for an applicant who is from a local farming background and has been in	
	business for several years. The information provided in the proposal was considered to offer a	
	comprehensive picture of intention and viability. It was noted that being on site will be beneficial	
	for the rearing of calves and reduce the risk of theft and vandalism which is currently occurring. The	
	dwelling itself, which is intended as the applicant's family home, was deemed to be a reasonable	
	size for a family of four, (140m2), and well within the permitted limit. Cllr Gosney proposed the	
	"Parish Council support the application in principal provided the independent assessor is satisfied	
	with the financial viability of the proposal and subject to any possible covenants/restrictions on the	
	land. The application meets NDC's local plan policy to encourage the development of sustainable	
	farming in rural areas with the expansion and development of agriculture to the benefit of the rural	
	community." Cllr Mrs Munster seconded, unanimously agreed. <b>RESOLVED.</b>
